::Online Hostel Allotment (2nd Year Onwards)::

Allocation to the hostel for all students (2nd Year Onwards) will be made from 27-07-2025 (02:00 PM) to 31-07-2025 (05:30 PM) through the Online Hostel Management System (OHMS) which can be accessed through https://hostels.gbu.ac.in/ohms.

- Students need to login to OHMS (Online Hostel Management System) using their already registered Roll Number/Enrollment Number and Password. Subsequently, the students can choose the room of their choice and get it allocated.
- Please note that hostel allotment will be made through OHMS only.

Key Details:

- 1. Allotment Date: The Online Hostel Allotment will begin on 27/07/2025 (02:00 PM) and will continue up to 31/07/2025 (05:30 PM).
- 2. Eligibility: All 2nd Year and onwards students are eligible for online hostel allotment subject to the academic promotion and fee payment.

3. Accessing the System:

- a. Visit the University's Hostels Website [https://hostels.gbu.ac.in/ohms] and login to the OHMS Student Portal.
- b. Login yourself using Enrollment Number/Roll Number and Password. Allotment will be done on first come first serve basis.

4. Allotment Procedure:

- a. Pay Your Academic, Hostel, Mess and Common Fees (ONLINE Mode) as applicable (Please refer to Order: GBU-002/Admn./7.7/2025-26/3522 dt. 01/07/2025 as issued by Finance Office). Payment made in a different mode may take upto two working days for the update.
- b. Login to the OHMS System using Enrollment Number/Roll Number and Password.
- c. Book your hostel room and select your preferences for room sharing (In case of girls only).
- d. There are limited number of Double Seater Rooms for **Female Students** and request of the same will be approved only on **First Come First Serve basis**. Request for Double Seater Up-gradation can be raised from Chief Warden (Female) Office. After subsequent approval and as per the availability of Double Seater rooms, it will be updated from Chief Warden (Female) Office.
- e. After successful booking, download Hostel Intimation Slip and respective forms (Form-A, Form-B, Declarations & Items Checklist, Undertaking: Anti-Ragging, Undertaking- General Rules and Regulations, Medical Information Form) from your dashboard.
- f. Take the printout of all forms along with hostel intimation slip.
- g. Fill all-star marked fields in the form manually and duly sign all the forms (Signature by parent/guardian also required).
- h. Report in the hostel allotted to you on 28/07/2025 or 29/07/2025 along with duly signed forms for final document verification and take possession of your room.
- Hostel Office will provide you the Mess Card to be used for dining purpose after processing of filled forms.
- i. Room once allotted online is not-transferable.
