74TH CONSTITUTION DAY CELEBRATION

On November 20, 2023, the School of Law, Justice, and Governance at Gautam Buddha University organized a grand program on the occasion of 74th Constitution Day of India. The Chief Guest for the event Justice Pradeep Shrivastav, Chairman of the Uttar Pradesh Law Commission. He elaborated on the significance of judicial review process in general, and discussed about the formation of Indian constitution, the efforts involved in it, and the perspectives of the constitution-makers. He said that the Indian Constitution is a social document, the only document of its kind. He also stressed the crucial role of lawyers and associations in resolving pending legal cases in India. This event was organized as part of Constitution Week celebration program. It included an interuniversity parliamentary debate, an intra-university quiz competition, poster-making, and rangoli contests.

PARTICIPATION OF GAUTAM BUDDHA UNIVERSITY'S VICE-CHANCELLOR IN THE 73RD ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION OF NALANDA MAHAVIHARA





On November 21, 2023, during the 73rd anniversary celebration of Nalanda Mahavihara, Gautam Buddha University's Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Ravindra Kumar Sinha, was invited as a distinguished guest. During this event, Prof. Ravindra Kumar Sinha highlighted that Nalanda Mahavihara is renowned for the study of Pali, Buddhist studies, and other subjects. He encouraged everyone to visit Nalanda University for knowledge enhancement. The next day he also interacted with the students and professors there.

Workshop on 'Modern Trends in Research Methodology: From November 21st to 23rd, 2023, the School of Law, Justice, and Governance, Gautam Buddha University, in collaboration with the India Digital Academy, Aligarh, organized a three-day workshop on 'Modern Trends in Research Methodology.' The objective of the program was to provide participants with an overview of the latest trends in research methodology, focusing on qualitative and quantitative approaches. Dr. Vishwas Tripathi, the Registrar of Gautam Buddha University, was the chief guest in the event. In the inaugural session of the workshop, a research paper presented by Professor Naushad Ali from Aligarh Muslim University highlighted the importance of research methodologies in the field of law. He emphasized that the choice of research methodology depends on the type of research questions and the data collected. On the subsequent days there were lectures by Professor Nazim on 'Academic Writing and its Enhancement,' Dr. Raj Kumar Bhardwaj on 'Writing Research Grant Proposals,' and Mr. Rafiq on 'The Role of Artificial Intelligence and Modern Technology in Research'. Mr. Rafique advised participants on effective use of Al but also cautioned against excessive reliance on it. He said too much reliance on Al tools might hinder creative skills. Dr. Manorama from JNU discussed measures to prevent intellectual theft and avoid predatory journals for publications. The concluding session was led by Shri R.B. Sharma. He emphasized on the importance of individual's fundamental duties and the duty to strive for excellence.



Publication of Research **Paper** by Research Scholar Tarana Singh: Tarana Singh, a research scholar from Gautam Buddha University's Department Computer Science in collaboration with the School of Information and Communication Technology, successfully published copyrighted paper titled 'A Novel IoT & ML based Framework for Smart Home Energy Management Recommendation System Using Integration Affinity Propagation Algorithm with SWIMAX Gated Kaiming Recurrent Unit Technique.' The research work aims to optimize energy in smart homes using Artificial Intelligence and internet contributing to cleaner and greener smart city solutions for projects developing countries like India.



CONVOCATION

On December 24, 2023, a grand convocation ceremony was held in the main auditorium of Gautam Buddha University. The presence of distinguished guests, like Honorable Vice-President of India Mr. Jagdeep Dhankhar and Honorable Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh and Chancellor of Gautam Buddha University Yogi Adityanath among others added splendor to the ceremony. In this ceremony, degrees were conferred upon 7914 students, that included PhD, postgraduation and graduation degrees, from 8 departments of the university. Honorable Vice-President Mr. Jagdeep Dhankhar presented gold medals and certificates to 8 students for their achievements. Additionally, degrees were awarded to students from Myanmar, Vietnam,

Laos, Thailand, and Taiwan.





Honorable Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Ravindra Kumar Sinha, highlighted the university's achievements in his welcome address, and expressed happiness over the recent 'Academic Excellence Award 2023' bestowed upon Gautam Buddha University. He attributed the university's progress to the guidance of Honorable Chancellor Yogi Adityanath and expressed hope that GBU will soon achieve the standard of a Global University. He cited the numerous conferences, seminars, FDPs (Faculty Development Programs), expert lectures, and workshops organized by various departments in the university in past two years, and mentioned that they showcased the commitment of the GBU faculty towards research and knowledge sharing. He also mentioned the success of the university in hosting various national and international events with the support of Indian government bodies like AICTE, such as UNESCO-India-Africa Hackathon, Khelo India University Games 2022, Regional Games, and the Asian Games. He shared the fact that there has been consistent increase in the admission rate in the university over last few years. He concluded by congratulating the students and extending his best wishes for their bright future.



While addressing the students, the Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh and the Honorable Chancellor of Gautam Buddha University, Yogi Adityanath, inspired them to follow the principles of Mahatma Gautam Buddha.
