

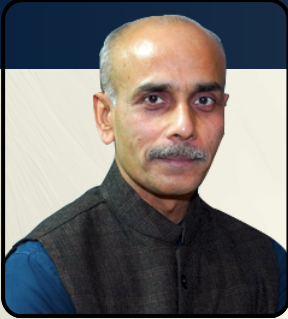

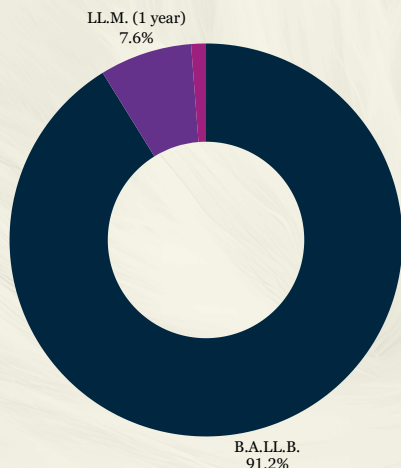

# RECRUITMENT PROCESS

## 01. Formal Invitations

Internship & Placement Committee (IPC) SoLJ&G, GBU sends formal invitation and relevant information regarding Campus Placement to the law firm/companies

## 03. Placement Schedule

The IPC, SoLJ&G decides the final placement schedule of tests with law firm/companies after mutual discussion and consent. All opportunities offered by law firms / companies are shared with students.

## 05. Selected Candidates

The law firm/company can interview the shortlisted students and finally submit the list of selected students.

## 02. Job Notifications Form

Law firm/companies can register by filing up the internship Notification form or job Notification Form. Any law firm/company if interested in organizing a Pre-Placement Talk (PPT) can share their request along with relevant details.

## 04. Recruitment Process

Interested students can apply for the recruitment process through prescribed form. Recruiters will be at liberty to conduct tests to shortlist candidates before moving forward with the interviews.
