



01. Formal Invitations

Internship & Placement Committee (IPC) SoLJ&G, GBU sends formal invitation and relevant information regarding Campus Placement to the law firm/companies

03. Placement Schedule

The IPC, SoLJ&G decides the final placement schedule of tests with law firm/companies after mutual discussion and consent. All opportunities offered by law firms / companies are shared with students.

05. Selected Candidates

The law firm/company can interview the shortlisted students and finally submit the list of selected students.

02. Job Notifications form

Law firm/companies can register by filing up the internship Notification form job or Notification Form. law Any firm/company if interested in organizing a Pre-Placement Talk (PPT) can share their request along with relevant details.

04. Recruitment Process

Intrerested students can apply for the recruitment process through prescribed form. Recruiters will be at liberty to conduct tests to shortlist candidates before moving forward with the interviews.
