INTRODUCTION

Academic Program offered by the Department:

The Department currently offers program in the area of Psychology at Graduation, Post-Graduation and higher research level which are:

- **1. B.A. /B.Sc. (Honors) in Applied Psychology**, a Six semester-3 years programme.
- M.A./M.Sc. in Applied Psychology (Specializations in Clinical Psychology, Counselling Psychology and Organizational Psychology), a Four semesters-2years programme.
- M. Phil. (Clinical Psychology), 2 years programme (RCI Accredited)
- 4. Ph.D. (Applied Psychology, Clinical Psychology, Forensic Psychology)

The Course Curriculum for Graduation, Post-Graduation& Ph.D. program are designed in accordance with **UGC** guidelines and for the M. Phil. (Clinical Psychology) course, it is as per the **Rehabilitation Council of India** (RCI) guidelines.

The department has established the "Clinical Psychology O.P.D", "Psychology Laboratory" and "Brain Behavior Research Laboratory" which facilitate the practical training and clinical exposure of the students and provides mental health services to the people in need. The details of the activities of these programs are as below:



LAB FACILITIES

Applied Psychology-Applied psychology is a field that focuses on putting practical research into action. Applied psychology focuses on the implementation of realworld results over abstract theories and lab-based experiments. This discipline validates psychology theories in order to achieve tangible results. The department facilitates the psychological assessments in this area through Intelligence tests, Cognitive tests, Personality tests, Aptitude tests, and leadership skills at work place.

Clinicalpsychology-Clinical psychology is the psychological specialty that provides continuing and comprehensive mental and behavioral health care for individuals and families. The specialty of clinical psychology addresses behavioral and mental health issues faced by individuals across the lifespan including Intellectual, emotional, psychological, social and behavioral mal-adjustment. The department facilitates the psychological assessments in this area through Bender Visual Motor Gestalt



Test, Rorschach Test, Thematic Apperception Test etc.



Brain behavior Research Laboratory-Includes studies of sensation and perception, learning and memory, attention, mental imagery, conceptual representation, aging, language, emotion, motor control, social cognition, moral decision making, and neurological Methodologies disorders. include computer-based behavioral tests and web-based surveys to assess functional patterns in behavior, as well asfunctional neuroimaging techniques.

The department facilitates the psychological assessments in this area through -

- BrainFingerprinting Technology-It is a technique that is advocated as a way to identify a terrorist by measuring the Brain print of that person. Currently this technology is only available in our department in the whole of North India. The department is providing opportunities to young budding research scholars to explore the extended applications of this technology to clinical and forensic psychology areas.
- Brain tapping Brain tapping is a quick and easy way to relax, reboot and revitalize by simply optimizing your brain's peak potential—anytime, anywhere. ... Unlike meditation programs, Brain Tap's exclusive neuro-algorithms gently and naturally guide your brain through a broad range of brainwave patterns, instead of just the Alpha state.
- Neurofeedback-Neurofeedback, also known as EEG (electroencephalogram) biofeedback, is a therapeutic intervention that provides immediate feedback from a computerbased program that assesses a client's brainwave activity. The program then uses sound or visual signals to reorganize or retrain these brain signals.

In O.P.D. the Department has provisions of **Psycho-diagnostic** assessment, **Psychotherapeutic management of psychological** problems, **Psychotherapeutic intervention & counseling**, **Neuro**biofeedback training and relaxation therapy by EEG, ECG & EMG machines to the patients of depression, anxiety, phobia, OCD, tension headache and other psychological conditions.


