FLIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

Academic Eligibility Criteria

Minimum Qualifications

- (1) As per the AICTE Notification No. F.No. 61-1/RIED/7th CPC/2016-17, dated 1st March, 2019 for:
 - a. Engineering/Technology

B.E./B.Tech./B.S. and M.E./M.Tech./M.S. or Integrated M.Tech. in relevant branch with first class or equivalent in any one of the degrees.

b. Management

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline and Master's Degree in Business Administration/PGDM/C.A./ICWA/M.Com. with first class or equivalent, and two years of professional experience after acquiring the Master's Degree.

(2) As per the UGC Notification No. F.1-2/2017 (EC/PS) dated the 18th July, 2018 for the disciplines of Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities and Law

Eligibility (A or B):

- A-(i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- A-(ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the UGC's (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D Degree) Regulations 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be, exempted from NET/SLET/SET. *Provided*, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree, and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:
- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conference/seminar sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: The clearing of NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Master Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

B. The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli

Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note: The Academic score as specified by the UGC in Appendix II (Table 3A), annexed herewith as Annexure I, for Universities shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for Multiple round of academic assessment. This may include written test, presentation (including action plan), seminar etc. followed by the interview by the duly-constituted Selection Committee.

- A relaxation of 5 (five) percent in marks or equivalent relaxation in Grade is allowed in case of SC/ST/Physically Challenged (Differently-abled) candidates on production of valid certificate. Similar relaxation in age, if applicable, will be permissible as per U.P. Government Norms.
- Academic eligibility criteria mentioned in (1) and (2) are the minimum requirement, and the (4)University may set-up new criteria with higher qualification and experience, based on the recommendations of the Screening Committee duly constituted by the University.
- The University reserves the right to fill or not to fill the posts advertised. Merely fulfilling the (5) minimum eligibility criteria does not mean that the applicant will be called for multiple round of academic assessment/Interview.
- (6)The Selection Committee may recommend for higher pay level to exceptionally-qualified candidates which will be judged based on quality publication in leading journals as first or single proven teaching, research and laboratory establishment experience, products/patents development.

Terms of Appointment:

- The appointment of the "Assistant Professor" shall initially be made on contract basis for a period of two years.
- The contract period of two years shall also be considered as the Probation period. The Probation period can be extended by a maximum period of one year.
- The services of an Appointed Assistant Professor can be terminated during the Probation period by giving one month notice by either the University or the Appointee. However, the Appointee on contract may be required to continue till the end of the Semester.

 Appointment letter to the successful candidates will be issued after (i) Medical examination by the Medical Board recommended by the University, and (ii) Vigilance clearance/ Police Verification, as the case may be. The services of the Assistant Professor may be regularised as per GBU rules.
